





This qualification will also support learners who want to progress into higher education, ultimately leading you into employment.

ENGLISH AND MATHS

If you are yet to pass a qualification in English and / or maths prior to starting your programme with us, you will be required to study one or both alongside your vocational qualification.

We know that English and maths can be challenging, so we have a specialist team here to support you in overcoming that challenge. The English and maths qualifications that you will acquire upon completion with us will either be GCSE or Functional Skills.

The benefits to study and achieving English and maths are:

- Further study opportunities, such as apprenticeships at Level 2 and above, the next level of vocational study and eventually University
- Employment opportunities; most employers require applicants to have a good foundation of English and maths skills. A lack of English and maths qualifications can often be a barrier to employment.

Support for students with additional needs and EHC plans

We offer a comprehensive package of support for students with additional learning needs and EHC Plans. This can include providing a Learning Support Assistant, personalised timetables, smaller group sizes, and one-to-one tutorials for extra tuition. We promote a nurturing and supportive learning environment and aim to develop the personal growth and wellbeing of our students through additional bespoke accredited and non-accredited training.



WORK EXPERIENCE AND CAREERS

There is nothing like hands-on experience. It helps you to apply the knowledge and skills that you have learned to a real-world situation, bringing your learning to life.

That is why, as part of your study programme, you will take part in a minimum of 37 hours of work experience.

You will also get the opportunity to experience a range of careers through your virtual and physical work experience.

This will help you chart the pathway to your dream job, as well as giving you valuable transferable skills in a number of roles.



CAREERS INFORMATION ADVICE AND GUIDANCE

Throughout your time with Total People, you will receive Careers information advice and guidance from our specialist team who will support you along your learning journey.

Induction

The first week will be made up of an engaging and information-filled induction, that will provide you with detailed information about each element of the programme, including safeguarding, prevent, British values and a range of other essential topics to start your learning journey.

Progress Reviews

Every six weeks, your vocational tutor will conduct a one-to-one session to discuss your progress on the programme. You will work with your tutor to set realistic but challenging targets that will set you up for success, not only in achieving your qualification, but in developing your personal skills.

Pathways

Within induction, at each review and as part of the tutorial package that you will complete as part of your programme, we will support you in finding and completing your chosen pathway, whether this is to continue in education or gain employment at the end of your time with us.

EXPECTATIONS AND BEHAVIOURS

Total People has high expectations for you as a learner for attendance and punctuality as they are both integral and fundamental to your learning journey. As our focus is to support transitions into positive destinations, as much as possible, we want to replicate the expectations and standards expected of you in the world of work.

During induction week, you will sign an agreement in line with the expectations of attendance and behaviour during your time on programme as detailed below:

- Take full responsibility and ownership for your individual learning and attendance
- Attend ALL scheduled sessions and additional compulsory activities associated with your programme
- Report absence to your learning coach by 8:30am, or as soon as reasonably possible, via phone call, email or Microsoft Teams
- Make medical appointments outside of timetabled hours where possible
- Not book holidays in term time
- Provide medical evidence for absences of three consecutive days or more

- Co-operate with Total People in respect of equality of opportunity, ensuring that behaviour is not discriminatory or bring pressure on others to discriminate
- Must abide by the student code of conduct and understand there will be consequences if this is breached
- Co-operate with Total People in respect of Health & Safety, and take reasonable care in all activities to safeguard the health & safety of yourself and others.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT
